a monumental task A note from your CEO

The minivan with a family of four, plus one on the way, pulled up at Food Share as I was leaving for the day. "We just drove down from Paradise," the mom explained with one hand on her baby bump. "We couldn't live with the ashes any longer. We had to leave." My heart went out to them, but I was relieved they had found Food Share at the end of their journey to find a better place to live "with neighbors."

As hunger relief workers, we are reminded daily of the hundreds of different families like the Paradise family that depend on Food Share to feed their families. As Ventura County's food bank, Food Share is faced with the responsibility of sourcing and providing food to 75,000 hungry people every month.

As we close our fiscal year, we would love to sit back and congratulate ourselves on a job well done. With a budget of \$3.5 million, 13.2 million pounds of food equaling nearly \$34 million worth of groceries was distributed. This is accomplished with a staff of 30 employees, 2,500 volunteers, and 190 non-profit partner organizations.

But the reality is that with the start of our new fiscal year on July 1, we once again face the task: of raising another \$3.5 million to acquire and distribute food. Most are surprised to learn that only about 25% of Food Share's revenue budget has a direct source. The remaining 75% comes through the generosity of our community through appeals, grants, donations — and some degree of serendipity.

A new fiscal year also brings some new, exciting changes to share; a new logo! Our brand has carried and supported us for the past 40 years and we are confident this new one will do the same: a new look but the same great heart.

senior kit program

FREE food for seniors 60+ years every month

Beverly M. and her husband live in Oxnard. They live on a fixed income and Beverly now takes care of her husband full time. There are some months where they fall a bit short and need that extra help. "I don't have to buy some of the food, because some things come in the senior kit box. It's a great supplement to what I am already able to get. It's really great food too," said Beverly.

The Senior Kit is a once-a-month, 30-pound box of shelf-stable food provided FREE to seniors aged 60+ who reside in Ventura County. The box has been a real help to Beverly and her husband. "I really appreciate what the program does for the seniors as a lot of people I know are in a similar situation to me and the Senior Kit box helps them out a lot also. Thank you Food Share!"

➤ To be eligible, applicants must be at least 60 years old, a resident of Ventura County and meet the federal income guidelines listed below. Applicants must apply in person.
