Position Summary

The CSFP Outreach Worker assists in the management of CSFP caseload, which includes but is not limited to: reminder calls to clients; marketing of the program to FOOD Share agencies and community- based organizations; application assistance; annual recertification; monthly issuance of food kits; produce daily/weekly/monthly reports as required; verification of kits distributed; distribution of nutrition education materials; and follow up with CSFP clients as needed.

Position Duties and Responsibilities

Assist in the management of CSFP caseload to include but not limited to:

- Market (outreach) program to Ventura County CBOs and seniors
- Assist in managing FOOD Share's assigned caseload through application assistance, annual recertification and monthly kit issuance.
- Aid the CSFP Manager in meeting program requirements set by the California Department of Social Services/USDA
- Work with Operations on the distribution of CSFP kits: coordinate daily distributions and provide verification of receipt and distribution of CSFP food kits
- Distribute nutrition education materials

- Experience in inventory control (FIFO, LIFO, cycle counts and month/year end inventory procedures)
