



Requirements for court ordered or probation volunteers

Requirements

The following items are required in order to be approved to complete hours with Food Share, Ventura County's Food Bank. If you are unable to provide these items, you will not be able to perform any scheduled hours.

1. You MUST have a valid photo ID with full name and birthdate.
2. A COPY OF the paperwork from probation officer, court document, or attorney stating:
 - a. Individual's name
 - b. specific offense(s) committed
 - c. Case number or docket number
 - d. Number of hours required
 - e. Due by date
 - f. The name and contact information of the probation officer or Attorney

Confirmation of hours

Hours will not be confirmed without volunteer orientation and submission of proper documentation prior to volunteering.

Schedule

- a. Can only complete hours at Food Share Headquarters. No off-site hours will be accepted.
- b. We offer M-F 8am-2pm working under Safety & Maintenance Department. You help with all things in the warehouse from cleaning, dusting, mopping, throwing out bad foods, etc.
- c. If you work for 4 hours you get one 10-minute break
- d. If you work for 6 hours you get two 10-minute breaks and one thirty-minute lunch.

We will not accept

A volunteer for community service for court, probation, or through a lawyer who is being charged, pleading guilty to, or having been found guilty of, certain serious offenses including but not limited to:

- a. Armed Robbery/burglary/theft
- b. Domestic violence – assault or abuse and/or battery of any kind
- c. Child abuse or Child endangerment of any kind
- d. Aggravated Assault (assault with a weapon)
- e. Kidnapping
- f. Arson
- g. Statutory/Sexual offense of any kind
