Food Share's work is critical to providing a healthy future for hundreds of thousands of neighbors in Ventura County. **Food Share feeds 250,000 people annually and distributes nearly 20 million pounds of food.** In the last 5 years, that number has more than tripled. Nearly **200 partner food pantries** rely on Food Share to feed their communities by sourcing fresh, shelf-stable, and culturally appropriate food, at no cost, to meet a diverse array of needs.
